



## Bay Springs Wild Hog Roundup Competition Rules

- 1. Registration must be received by 5:00 pm February 14, 2014.
- 2. You may register by:
  - Downloading The entry forms off of our Facebook page "Hog Hunting for Kids". Emailing <u>tyratodd@hotmail.com</u> and requesting an entry form. Contacting 601-670-5006 and requesting an entry form.
- 3. The registration per team is \$350.00 and is non-refundable.
- 4. Teams will consist of 1-4 people and you cannot be a member of multiple teams.
- 5. During the hunt the hog must be caught prior to human handling and must not be roped, run over or trapped.
- 6. Teams will be allowed to catch the hog alive for holding until check in but must be deceased upon arrival and must not be shot.
- 7. If, when hunting the hogs and dogs split resulting in multiple bays hunters are allowed to split up to harvest the hogs but must regroup as soon as possible.
- 8. This event is open to all legal hunters utilizing dogs for the purpose of harvesting wild feral hogs.
- 9. Weigh in starts Thursday February 20 at noon until February 22, 2:00 pm; only exception will be for teams traveling 500 miles or more and will be required to give notice with exact location and no more than a 2hr ETA to the weigh in past the deadline.
- 10. No team substitutions.
- 11. Leaders in all four categories will be published to the "Hog Hunting for Kids" Facebook page as they come in and will be available via phone @ 601-670-5006
- 12. All hogs must be harvested by knife, as humanely possible.
- 13. Only team members are allowed to participate in the hunt observers are allowed and can only assist in retrieving DEAD HOGS ONLY
- 14. For the purposes of this hunt, hogs are defined to be feral, free-ranging, wild hogs which have not been previously held, trapped, pen raised, and released for the purposes of being hunted in this contest and must not have been hunted from within a game fence.
- 15. The team captain must be present at check in.
- 16. Anyone behaving in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner will be asked to leave.
- 17. Complaints or objections can be made in the form of a written grievance and submitted to the contest officials before the announcement of the winners, which will take place after the weigh-in and review of qualifying teams. Once the final decision of the contest officials is made, the decision stands.
- 18. Each team will be issued a Team ID card once Registration is received and will be mailed to the Team Captain prior to the Official Start of the hunt.
- 19. Each team will be required to have a picture present at the weigh in with the Team ID, at least 2 team members, 2 dogs from the site of the harvest.
- 20. All contestants will be subject to a polygraph with refusal resulting in immediate disqualification of the team.
- 21. All federal and state wildlife laws where applicable are to be followed.
- 22. Categories include:

Biggest Boar Biggest Hog (sow/bar) Biggest 4 Hog stringer Biggest Tusk (combined length of tops and bottoms) 1<sup>st</sup> place in all categories will be \$500, a trophy and prizes 2<sup>nd</sup> place in all categories will be a trophy and prizes.
